## 主讲人简介 · Speaker Introduction

Rostam Josef NEUWIRTH is Professor of Law and Head of the Department of Global Legal Studies at the Faculty of Law of the University of Macau. He received his PhD degree from the European University Institute (EUI) in Florence (Italy), and also holds a Master's degree in Law (LL.M.) from the Faculty of Law of McGill University in Montreal (Canada). He is the author of Law in the Time of Oxymora: A Synaesthesia of Language, Logic and Law (Routledge 2018) and a forthcoming book entitled The EU Artificial Intelligence Act: Regulating Subliminal AI Systems (Routledge 2022).



## 讲座简介 · Lecture Description

Artificial Intelligence or “AI” in combination with other innovative technologies promises to bring unprecedented opportunities to all aspects of life. These technologies, however, equally hold great dangers, especially for the manipulation of the human mind, which have given rise to serious ethical concerns. Apart from some sectoral regulatory efforts to address these concerns, no regulatory framework for AI has yet been adopted though in 2021 the European Commission of the EU published a draft Act on Artificial Intelligence (AIA) and UNESCO followed suit with a Recommendation on the Ethics of Artificial Intelligence.

In his lecture, Prof. Rostam J. Neuwirth will first address the principal regulatory challenges related to AI before specifically focusing on the EU AIA's planned prohibition of the use of AI systems that deploy subliminal techniques. Second, the lecture will explain the underlying psychological and cognitive problems related to subliminal perception and the study of the senses, before it concludes with a brief outlook to futures thinking and the future of law in general.
